Scientists at London's Natural History Museum discovered six new species of frogs in Mexico that are smaller in size than a penny. The male members of these species, named *Craugastor candelariensis*, can grow up to 13 mm in length..

Captain Shiva Chauhan of Leh-based Fire and Fury Sappers became the first woman officer to be operationally deployed by the Indian Army at Kumar Post, located at an altitude of 15,632 feet in Siachen Glacier.

Former astronaut Walter Cunningham passed away at the age of 90 in Houston due to natural causes. He was the last surviving member of the three-astronaut crew aboard Apollo 7, which was the first successful crewed space mission in NASA's Apollo program.

A 120-million-year-old fossil, which seems to have a dinosaur-like head and bird-like body was discovered in China. Named '*Cratonavis zhui*', it has an elongated scapula and first metatarsal bones, making it stand out from all other birds.

India will deploy a platoon of women peacekeepers, consisting of 2 officers and 25 other ranks in Abyei region located between Sudan and South Sudan, as part of the Indian Battalion in the UN Interim Security Force.


India beat Sri Lanka by 91 runs in the third T20I in Rajkot to win the series 2-1. Suryakumar Yadav was adjudged 'Player of the Match' for scoring 112 runs, while Axar Patel became the 'Player of the Series'.

Hawaii's Kilauea volcano, which had last erupted in September 2021, erupted inside its Halemaumau Crater in the US. The alert level was raised to "red" after the evaluation of the eruption and associated hazards.

NASA's Hubble Space Telescope, Chandra X-ray Observatory and Spitzer Space Telescope captured an image showing the heart of Milky Way galaxy. The image was captured using infrared and X-ray spectrums of light.
