

OpenAI, the company behind AI chatbot ChatGPT, introduced 'Voice Engine'- an AI model which replicate any voice in any language by using a 15 second audio sample. Users can upload an audio sample and use it to generate an audio clip in the same voice and manner of speaking.

NATO (North Atlantic Treaty Organisation) marked its 75th anniversary at a Foreign Ministers meet at NATO Headquarters, Brussels. The 32-country organisation marked 75 years since the signing of the Alliance's founding document, the North Atlantic Treaty.

Arjun Erigaisi became the top ranked Indian Chess player as per the latest FIDE rankings. With a standard rating of 2756, Erigaisi is ranked ninth in the world. Following him is

Over 60 Indian products have received a GI tag- the first time that such a large number have been accorded simultaneously. These include the Jaapi (bamboo headgear of rural Assam) and the famous Banaras Thandai.

Weightlifter Bindyarani Devi won a bronze and a silver medal in the women's 55 kg category, at the IWF World Cup 2024, held at Phuket, Thailand. She thus became the first Indian woman to win an event in this category.

Venezuelan Juan Vicente Perez, died on 2 April 2024, at the age of 114. He was certified the world's oldest human in 2022 by Guinness World Records. He credited his longevity to working hard and praying twice a day.

Former PM Manmohan Singh ended his 33-year-long tenure in the Rajya Sabha. 91-year-old Singh was first elected to the Rajya Sabha in 1991. After serving as finance minister from 1991-1996, when he heralded liberalisation in India's economy, he served as India's prime minister from 2004-2014.
